The subject site is located approximately on the East side of J & E ST. at the intersection of N. J & E Street and E. Garza Street - as seen in the vicinity map. The surrounding zoning include to the East and South C-1 (Central Business District) to the North, R-2 (High Density Residential District), and to the West R-1 (Low Density Residential District). 
BACKGROUND




NEED

Mayor Sergio Coronado called the meeting to order at 6:04 pm, with all quorum present.

2. Pledges to the Flags and Invocation.

Mayor led the pledges of allegiance to the United States flag and the Texas flag. Police Chief Romeo Rodriguez gave the invocation.

3. Public Hearing.

3.1 Conditional Use Permit for the use of Phytosanitary Treatment located at 1001 East Ramon Ayala Drive Tract 1 Villarreal –De Los Rios Subdivision.

Mayor stated agenda item as Conditional Use Permit for the use of Phytosanitary Treatment. Deputy City Manager Virgil Gonzalez presented item and explained the location, it was an existing facility, handling of produce, the added component phytosanitary, to expand and sanitize the life of produce. Deputy City Manager stated owner Frank Benso was present to provide further information and item went in front of Planning and Zoning on March 2nd and staff recommended approval, but before Mr. Benso would present. Mr. Benso presented a video and explained what their procedure would consist of in detail. Mayor Coronado and Mr. Benso discussed things like the infrastructure, truck traffic, truck limitations, ownership details, job opportunities, radiation effects for residents in the surrounding area, school field trips, sanitation process, similar process in the area, and the length of construction. Councilmember Gustavo Sanchez and Mr. Benso discussed the commencing of the operation in Mississippi, irradiation concerns, what irradiation does, other locations aside from Mississippi, expert evaluation, input of citizens around the area, building built with specifications for safety, risks when building, and having experts provide safety radius knowledge. Councilmember Sanchez asked for the expert to be obtained on the city's behalf, to provide a safety radius. City Attorney Ricardo Perez and Mr. Benso discussed other businesses conducting the same process in the area, located in McAllen, not having an approved certificate, and Mexico's imported products' irradiation. HEDC Director Prisciliano Trevino stated that HEDC had been working with Mr. Benso and Uriel Zambrado for about five (5) years, who previously presented prolongation of flowers, and

the city had been wanting the business to establish in the area to create jobs, and tax revenue. Mayor Coronado stated he was a warehouse critic, Mr. Benso stated they could not tear down the warehouse. Councilmember Sanchez, HEDC Director Trevino, and Mr. Benso discussed if another site was looked at, purchasing of the warehouse, discussing of looking into another open area away from neighborhoods, plans presented as is, danger, comparison to an x-ray, having daily exposure, dose level, and regulations. Mayor and Mr. Benso talked about understanding both sides of the situation, same experience with other location, comparison of both locations, review of requirements of setbacks, wall density, aware of concerns, light industrial zone, no manufacturing, and a brief description of the process.

4. Public Comments.

Mayor stated agenda item as Public Comment. City Secretary Erika De Hoyos confirmed there were no public comments.

5. Adjournment of Public Hearing to recommence with Regular Meeting.

Mayor entertained the motion to adjourn the public hearing and recommence the regular meeting, Councilmember Abram Ramirez so moved, and Mayor Pro-Tem Linda Ayala seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. The public hearing adjourned at 6:40 p.m.; thereafter, the regular meeting reconvened.

6. Approval and Authorization.

6.1 Consideration and action on approval of March 6, 2023, Regular Meeting Minutes.

Mayor presented agenda item as approval of March 6, 2023, Meeting Minutes. Mayor entertained a motion for approval of City Council City Minutes, Councilmember Abram Ramirez so moved, and Mayor Pro-Tem Linda Ayala seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

6.2 Consideration and action on assisting Hidalgo Commercial Plaza for some utility assistance for Phase II, at the South Jackson Development Site.

Mayor presented Hidalgo Commercial Plaza utility assistance. The Councilmembers, staff and Mark Wilkins discussed in detail the reasons for the request on this development, the future benefits for commerce in the area, and previous and potential businesses in Hidalgo. The request consisted of a reimbursement of \$322,500.00 to Mr. Wilkins for funds that were extended to secure the business and for future businesses. Mr. Wilkins discussed a billboard as a possible future agenda item that was brought to Council previously but was not executed. Recommended by Mayor was to give the City Manager and City Attorney authority to negotiate numbers and assure the revenue would pay for the reimbursement. Mayor entertained a motion to approve the utility assistance, Councilmember Abram Ramirez so moved, and Mayor Pro-Tem Linda Ayala seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

6.3 Presentation of Summary of 2018, 2019 and 2020 Payne Arena Financial Statements Audit and 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020 Payne Arena Payable to City of Hidalgo, Texas Report.

Mayor stated there was a presentation of Payne Arena Audits. The Councilmembers, staff and Manuel Garcia discussed the Payne Arena Audit report in detail, net positions, assets and liabilities, summary of operating revenues, ticket sales, ancillary revenue/concession, concession percentage, total revenues, personnel expenses, other services and charges, and promoter proceeds. Introduction and welcoming of the new Assistant Finance Director, Aidee Montalvo, occurred, and Mayor asked for the revenues and expenditures. Continued the review in detail of the audit with the total revenue versus total expense, yearly payment, revenue from Savor, electricity, request of the detailed amount of expenses, creation of break downs, create a meeting to focus on the Arena, and reiteration of ticket sales and other services and charges.

Councilmember Abram Ramirez stepped out of the meeting at approximately 7:10 pm, and later logged into the meeting virtually.

Mayor, Mr. Garcia, and City Manager discussed the arena grant, the reroofing project, and its effect, if any, on the audit.

Recommendation by staff was to approve the selection of the lowest responsive bidder and award, if needed, selection of the next lowest responsive bidder. The Council, staff and Gustavo Jaramillo discussed in detail the request of the Consumer Price Index 5% increase, comparison of previous company, had not requested an increase, entertain the adjustment based on cost of living, fuel, and other cost that have increased, residential fees remaining the same, fund of the 5% increase, reasons behind the request, provide good services, resident's complaints, resolutions of complaints, and complainants communicating with the city. Mayor referred to agenda item 6.11, (c), bid purchase, and stated it was not approved, no motion needed.




REPLAT OF LOT 17, CYSTAL SUBDIVISION LOCATION MAP


REVIEW DATA
